This month, six Skills for Success courses have launched: Plumbing Assistant, Forklift Operator, Machine Operator, Concrete Mixer Truck Driver, Nursery Landscape Worker, and Flooring **Installation Technician**. Each course is designed to equip Alabamians with the skills needed to enter high-demand industries such as construction, manufacturing, transportation, and landscaping.

STRENGTHENING THE FIBER OF ALABAMA'S WORKFORCE

Calhoun Community College held a Skills for Success Fiber Optics Technician and Installer lab for Lineworker students and current employees looking to upskill. The training focused on hands-on lab experience, giving participants the opportunity to practice fiber splicing, testing, and installation.
